




Passover Timeline

<p style="text-align: center;">14th of Nisan</p> <p style="text-align: center;">The killing of the Passover lambs (Exodus 12:21) Blood placed on doorposts (V.22) Roasting the Passover lamb with bitter herbs (V..8-9)</p> <p>None could go out of his house until morning, including Moses (v.22)</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Death of Egypt's firstborn at midnight (v.29) News of deaths is obtained from around Egypt (V.30) Pharaoh <i>calls</i> for Moses (V.31)</p>		<p style="text-align: center;">14th of Nisan</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Footwashing service instituted (John 13:4-10) Passover symbols (1Corinthians 11:23-26) Judas went to betray Jesus (John 13:18-27)</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Jesus teaches the disciples (John 14-16)</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Jesus prays to His Father (John 17) Judas came and betrayed Him (Matthew 26:47, 57) Trial by the Sanhedrin (v.63 - Ch. 27:2) Scourged by Romans (John 19:1-4) Peter denies Jesus three times (Matthew 26:34)</p>
<p>In the morning they can leave their houses (V.22) They must burn the remains of their Passover meals (V.10)</p> <p>They grind grain and make bread dough for their journey (V.34)</p> <p style="text-align: center;">They visit Egyptians and request articles and goods (V.35-36) Joseph's remains are collected for the trip (Ch. 13:19) 2-3 million people gather their possessions, herds (perhaps 9 million animals) for travel (V.38)</p> <p>They view Egyptians burying their dead and animals (Numbers 33:3-4) All journey to a staging area in Rameses where they are organized into "armies" and "orderly ranks" (V.51; Ch. 13:18)</p>		<p style="text-align: center;">6am - Sentenced, <i>Roman time</i> (John 19:14) 9 a.m. Crucifixion process begins (Mark 15:25)</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Noon – Darkness, <i>Jewish time</i> (Matthew 27:45) 3 p.m. Jesus died (v. 46, 50)</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Signs and miracles (v.47-54)</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Joseph obtains the body (v. 57; Luke 23:52-55)</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Burial just before sunset on Nisan 14 (John 19:31)</p>

<p style="text-align: center;">15th of Nisan</p> <p>At evening the first ranks begin the 20-mile/10-hour night-time journey to Succoth (Ch. 12:41) It is a Night of solemn observance (V.42)</p> <p>The Feast of Unleavened Bread spanned from sunset at the end of Nisan 14 to sunset at the end of Nisan 21 (V.18, Leviticus 23:6-8)</p> <p style="text-align: center;">At Succoth they baked the bread (Exodus 12:39)</p>		<p style="text-align: center;">15th of Nisan</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Holy Day begins in Jerusalem (Luke 23:56)</p> <p style="text-align: center;">It is a Night to be Much Observed</p> <p style="text-align: center;">The Feast of Unleavened Bread spanned from sunset at the end of Nisan 14 to sunset at the end of Nisan 21 (Luke 23:54-56, Ch. 24:1)</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Meal preparation work is permitted (Exodus 12:16)</p>
