


In the beginning God made the world. For six days God worked. (Color the picture.)

On the first day God made the day and the night. (Find a picture showing day and one showing night. Paste them on this page.)




On the second day God made the air we breathe by dividing the waters above the earth from the waters under the earth. (Color the picture.)


On the third day God made the land, seas, plants and trees. (Find pictures of these and paste them on this page.)




On the fourth day God caused the sun, moon and stars to become visible. (Color the picture.)



Connect the dots to find what God caused to become visible on the fourth day.




On the fifth day God made the birds and the sea animals. (Color the picture.)

(In each circle write the number of the day on which the pictured events took place.)


