MOSES IS CALLED BY GOD

After the death of Joseph and his brothers, their families continued to live in the land of Egypt. There they became known as **Israelites**.



young girl ran to Pharaoh's daughter and asked, "Will you need someone to nurse the baby?"



When Pharaoh heard the news, he wanted to kill Moses. Moses had to quickly leave Egypt. He fled to the land of Midian where he became a shepherd for a man named Jethro. He later married Jethro's daughter, Zipporah.



One day, while Moses tended his father-in-law's sheep near Mount Sinai, he noticed a nearby bush was on fire. As he went near, he was surprised to see that the bush was not being burned up. Then God spoke to Moses out of the burning bush. God told Moses to remove his shoes because the ground where he stood was **holy**.


"Pick it up by the tail," God said. Moses slowly reached down and grabbed it by the tail. The snake became a rod in his hand.




Moses was afraid and told God that he could not speak well. So God agreed to let Moses' brother, Aaron, go with him and talk to Pharaoh.

In our next lesson, we will learn what God did to free the Israelites.









